December's Balance: \$765.16

Bills paid: Verizon \$3.68; Public Storage \$105; Rent \$75

New Balance: \$581.48

We made a deposit of \$1156.73, verified by bank. Making a new balance of \$1738.21

As our policy states we should have a Prudent Reserve in the amount of \$1,000. That leaves \$738.21 to fund our other escrow accounts, also known as line items in the budget. We can not fund all of them with this amount of money. Our budget review meeting tomorrow may help understand which ones to fund first.
